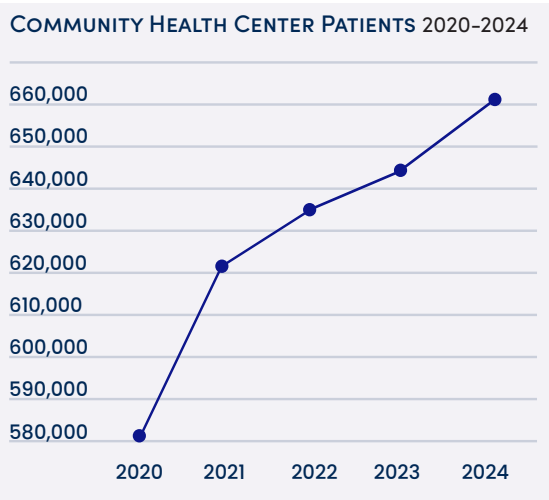
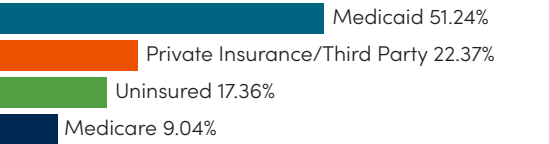

About Community Health Centers

Missouri Community Health Centers, also known as Federally Qualified Health Centers (FQHCs), are local, non-profit, community-driven health care providers on the leading edge of efforts to improve health outcomes throughout the state, particularly for low-income families.

For over 50 years, Missouri’s Community Health Centers have provided high-quality, affordable primary care and preventive services, and often provide on-site dental, pharmaceutical, mental health, and substance use disorder services – in each region of the state and individuals from every county and the City of St. Louis.

Community Health Centers are located in areas where care is vitally needed but scarce. They improve access to care for thousands of Missourians regardless of their insurance status or ability to pay.

FQHCs are at the forefront of national efforts to Make America Healthy Again (MAHA) through increasing access to chronic disease prevention and management (e.g. hypertension, diabetes), nutrition counseling, patient health education services, cancer screenings, and comprehensive primary health care services – including preventive services, mental health, and wellness activities. A recent budget request to Congress noted specifically that FQHCs dramatically reduce overall health care spending.

Community Health Center patients are among Missouri’s least secure populations. People who, even if insured, would remain isolated from traditional forms of care because of where they live, who they are, or their higher levels of complex health care needs.

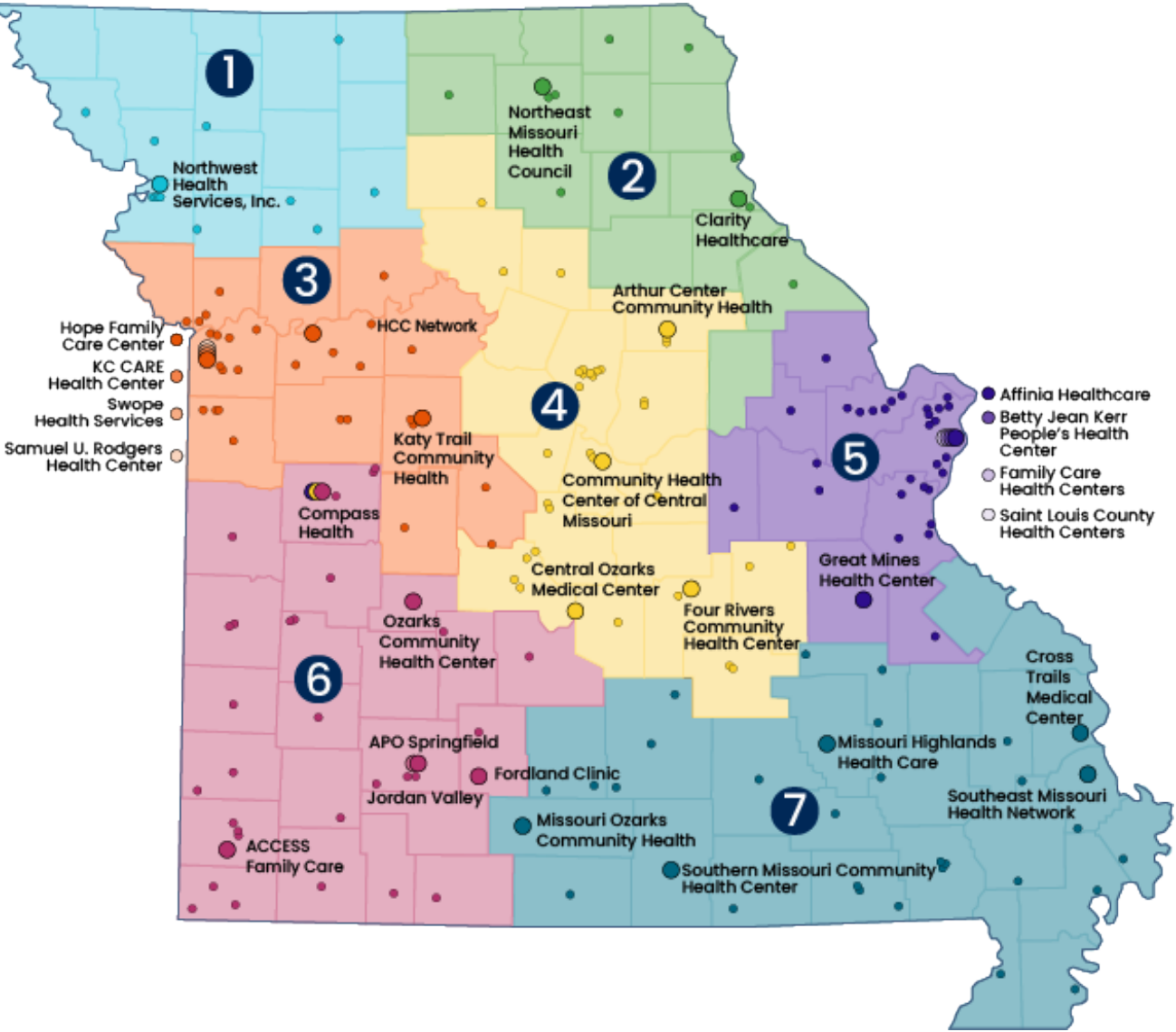
